How personal data is processed in Mexico

Except as otherwise indicated, this privacy policy (hereinafter referred to as "this Policy") governs the processing of personal data in Mexico.

This Policy is written in Spanish and translated into other languages. In case of discrepancies or inconsistencies between the Spanish and other languages, the Spanish version shall prevail.

5. International Transfer of Personal Data

Our group may transfer personal data* collected from you to a different country/region from where you reside (hereinafter referred to as "international transfer") to process it. When our group conducts international transfer of your personal data, our group will appropriately protect your personal data by taking one or more of the following safeguards:

- · Obtaining consent: Our group will obtain explicit consent from you.
- Conclusion of a contract with the recipient: Our group will conclude a contract between our group and the recipient of personal data to ensure that the recipient has the same level of personal data protection as our group.
- Compliance with our group's basic regulation: Our group will ensure that the recipients of personal data comply with our group's basic regulation (our group policies for complying with laws and regulations of countries/regions relevant to our group) for within-group international transfer.
