5. International Transfer of Personal Data

- Adoption of mechanisms of binding self-regulation: Our group will adopt mechanisms of binding selfregulation between our group and the recipient of your personal data.
- Conclusion of a contract with the recipient of personal data: Our group will conclude a contract between our group and the recipient of personal data for explicit interests of the data subjects.
